

**Central Florida Fair
Youth Heifer Show
March 9-March 11, 2018**

All USDA Recognized Beef Cattle Breeds
Arrival: Friday, March 9, 2018 (9:00 AM-12:00 PM)
Show: Saturday, March 10, 2018 (12:00 PM)
Showmanship: Sunday, March 11, 2018 (10:00 AM)
Release: Sunday, March 11, 2018 (4:00 PM)

Heifer: a female bovine (often immature, but beyond the "calf" stage) less than 1 to 2 years of age that has never calved.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors must be a legitimate, active FFA member or 4-H member (8 years old or older as of September 1, 2017), and reside in one of the following counties; Brevard, Orange, Osceola, Lake, Seminole, Volusia. Anyone currently graduated or dropped out of school shall be ineligible to enter the show.
2. Each exhibitor/owner must assume all liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal, and any injury or death incurred by his/her animal.

ENTRIES

1. Exhibitors' may enter up to 3 animals. However, the Central Florida Fair reserves the right to limit the number of entries per person if we are at capacity.
2. There is a \$25 entry fee per head. All entries will be on-line.
3. Entries must be in the name of the exhibitor.
4. There is a \$10 entry fee for showmanship.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

1. All animals must meet health regulations as specified in the Rules of Exhibition as required by the Florida Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services.

GENERAL

1. **FOR 2018 THIS IS A BLOW AND GO SHOW...NO PRODUCT to be used the day of show.**
2. **NO BUTT FANS will be allowed in the walkways...NO EXCEPTIONS! Failure to comply with this rule will result in automatic disqualification and removal from the fairgrounds.**
3. Grooming chutes will be limited to one per exhibitor.
4. Grooming chutes will be confined to a designated area.
5. Generators must be outside and away for the main barn.
6. No unauthorized vehicles will be allowed on the grounds.

Official Central Florida Fair Show Ring Attire:

Official dress for FFA is as defined in the official manual (note comments below regarding shoes and pants). Other agricultural youth organization members must wear either black, white or green pants (**NO BLUE JEANS**), a white, long sleeved button up shirt with a collar. Shirts must be tucked into pants and belts are highly recommended. Ties or Bolo's are required. Skirts are not recommended. Closed toed shoes or boots must be worn. Athletic shoes (sneakers/tennis shoes) or boat shoes (Sperry's) are not acceptable. No hats may be worn.

SHOW REQUIREMENTS

1. All cattle will be weighed at the time of check-in.
2. All classes will be determined by weight and by the show committee.
3. Cattle may have calf at their side (brought to the fairgrounds).
4. There will **NOT** be a cow/calf class. The cattle will be judged on their own merit.
5. Cattle may be pregnant at the time of show.
6. All cattle must be 36 months or younger to show.
7. Cattle must not have shed their baby teeth. Any cattle missing or showing their adult teeth if mouthed will be disqualified.
